The Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM), (previously known as the Bombay Municipal Corporation) (BMC) has new crest, designed by Arvind Pradhan of the Architectural Department of the JJ School of Art, was approved on 31 March 1955 and began to be used on 15 August 1955. It consists of a four-panelled shield with an intertwining gold border. A lotus is placed at the base of the shield with a lion puissant surmounting the floral border. The left top and right bottom panels are in red with the remaining two in bright blue. The Gateway of India is depicted in the left top panel in white and red lines while the top right panel represents a factory in a geared wheel to symbolise the industrial importance of the city. The lower right panel has three sailing ships in a white outline, representing the city's importance as a port and commercial centre. The lower left panel has a symbolised interpretation of the MCGM building. The Chief Minister, B G Kher's suggestion of adopting the motto Yato Dharmastato Jaya – 'where there is righteousness there is victory' was readily accepted.

THIS VAST AREA IS NOW KNOWN AS BRIHANMUMBAI METROPOLITAN REGION.



The 'Bombay Stock Exchange' is the oldest Stock Exchange in Asia. Dates back to 1855, when four Gujarati and one Parsi Stock Brokers would gather under the trees in front of Mumbai's Town Hall. The group eventually moved to Dalal Street in 1874 'The Native Share & Stock Brokers Association' in 1875.

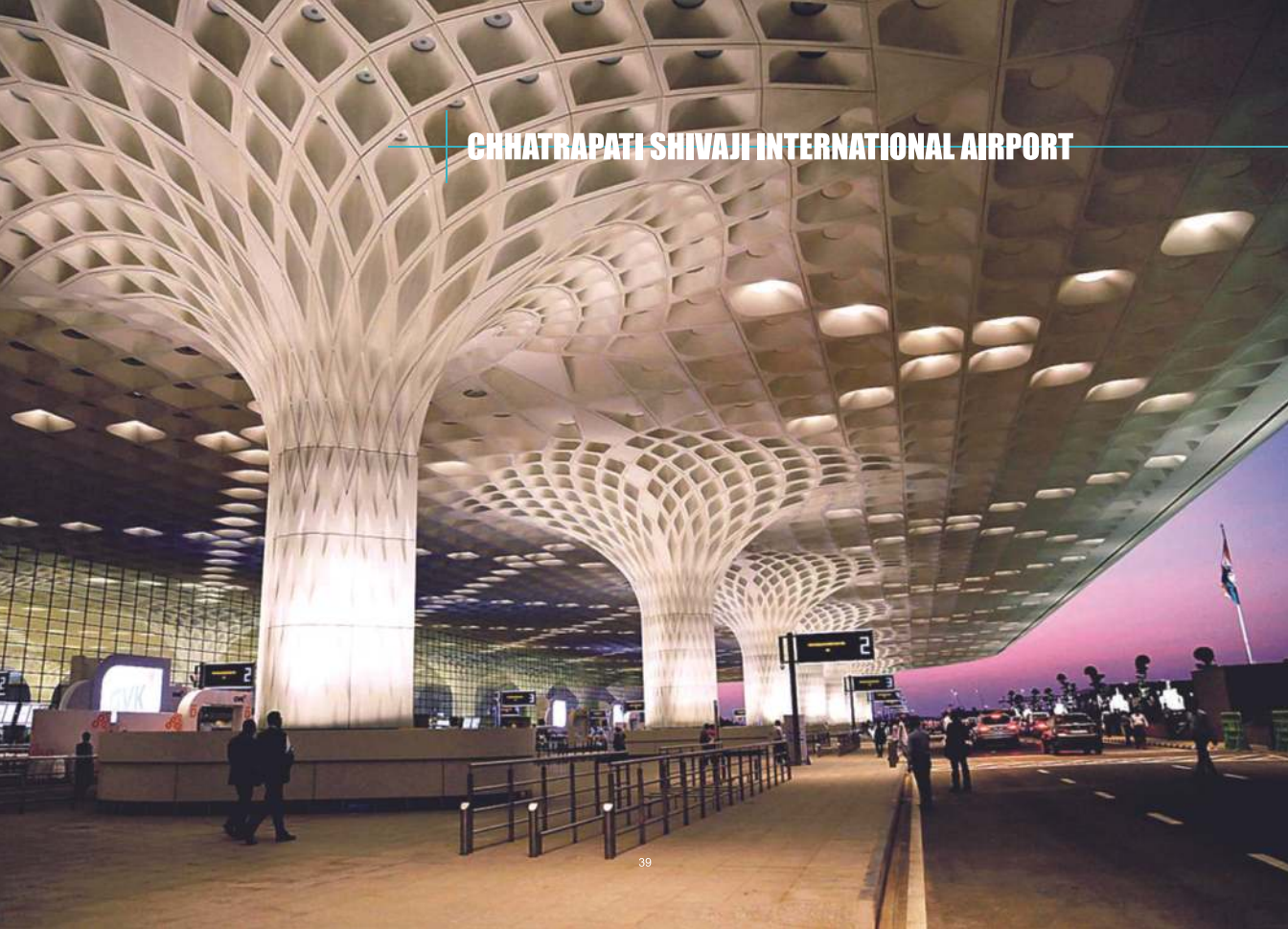
BANDRA - WORLI SEA LINK

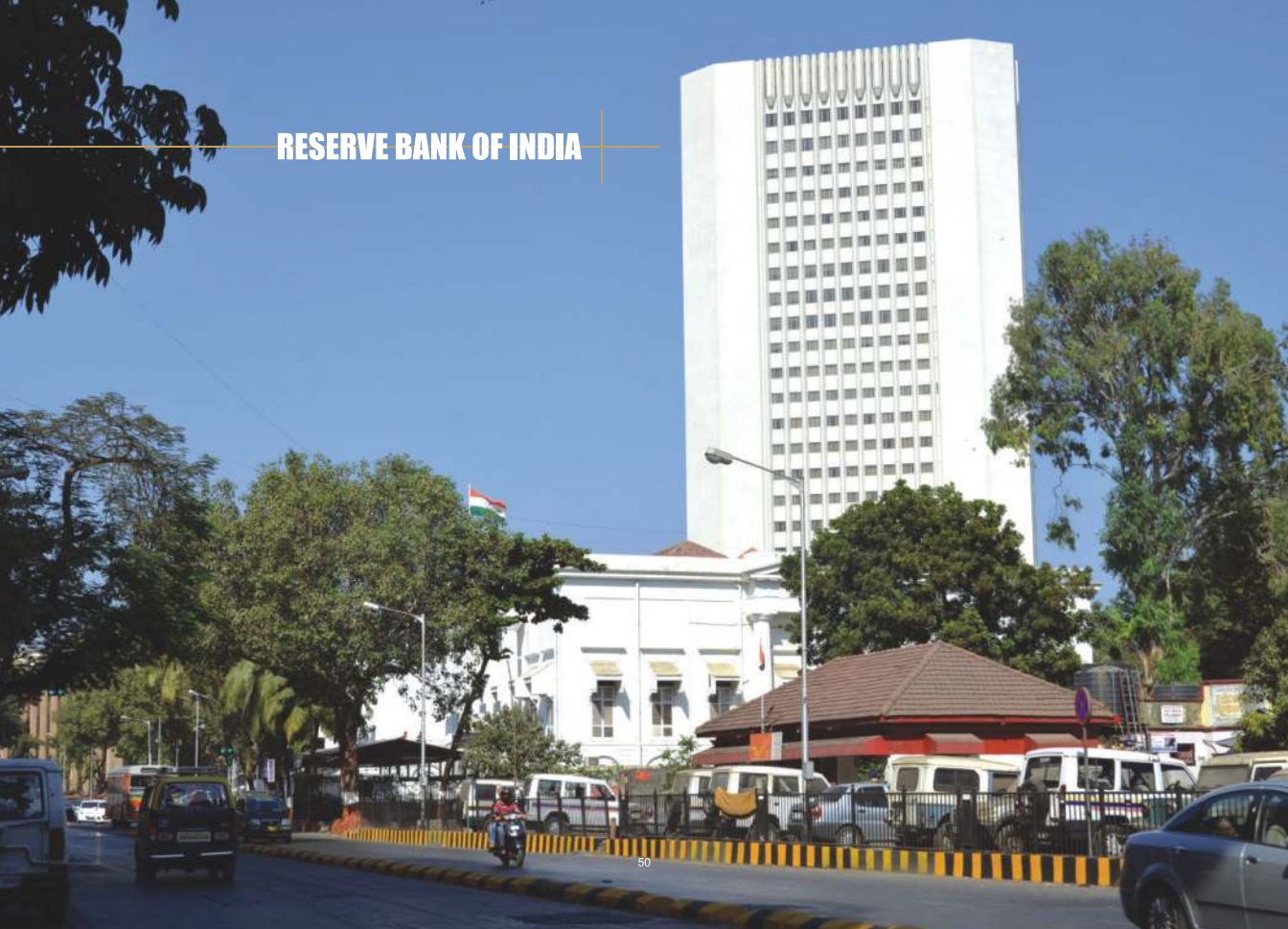
